SENATOR SID BUCKWOLD BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT BEGINS APRIL 15, 2019

The Senator Sid Buckwold Bridge will undergo a major rehabilitation starting on April 15, 2019. The project will also include improvements to the Idylwyld Drive over 19th Street ramps. Work will happen over the next two summers (2019 and 2010) in order to minimize the impact on traffic and eliminate the need for a full bridge closure.
