1. PURPOSE

To accommodate community needs and to optimize the use of facilities at or near Public and Catholic elementary schools.

2. POLICY

2.1 The City supports the construction of special use extensions to schools provided:

- a) The Parks and Recreation Department is satisfied that there is, in fact, a need for the extension (for example that there is no separate recreation unit being built or planned in the neighbourhood).
- b) The Parks and Recreation Department is satisfied with the proposed plans which may include extensions/additions to one or both of the Public and Catholic elementary schools in the same neighbourhood;
- c) The City receives a commitment from the School Boards to make the facilities available, upon request, for:
 - i) Playground programs outside of normal school hours and during the summer months.
 - ii) Skate changing rooms outside of normal school hours during the winter months,
 - iii) Activities of Neighbourhood Associations or other approved organizations (i.e. when not required for playground, or other normal school activities).
- d) Satisfactory financial and administrative arrangements are accepted by the City and the School Board and are covered by a formal written agreement.

2.2 The City's contribution to the extension/additions will be financed from the "prepaid services" fund, subject to approval by City Council in each instance.

3. RESPONSIBILITY

The Parks and Recreation Department is responsible for administering this policy.
