## NOTICE TO LOAN MONEY

### Bylaw No. 9530

Saskatoon City Council will consider Bylaw No. 9530, The Friends of the Bowl Foundation Inc. Loan Authorization Bylaw, 2018, at its meeting to be held on **Monday, August 27, 2018, at 6:00 p.m., Council Chambers, City Hall.**

The purpose of the Bylaw is to authorize a loan from the City of Saskatoon to The Friends of the Bowl Foundation Inc. for a capital fundraising program for Gordie Howe Sports Complex.

The principal of the loan will be for a sum of up to \$10,000,000, and the term shall be five years. Interest on the loan shall be at a rate equivalent to the City's calculated cost of borrowing and based on the balance of the loan. The City's rate of interest for the month of August 2018 was 2.67%.

*The Cities Act* and City Council Policy C01-021 require that City Council give public notice before loaning money to one of its closely controlled corporations.
