## NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF THE 2019 PROPERTY ASSESSMENT ROLL CITY OF SASKATOON

Pursuant to Section 187 of *The Cities Act*, notice is hereby given that the Property Assessment Roll for The City of Saskatoon for the year of 2019 has been prepared and will be open for public inspection at the Assessment and Valuation Office of Corporate Revenue, beginning January 2, 2019 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and statutory holidays.

**The Assessment Roll will remain open for inspection until February 4, 2019.**

Council has passed a bylaw pursuant to Section 184 of *The Cities Act* dispensing with the preparation of assessment notices for all properties. All required assessment notices will be mailed starting on January 2, 2019. Any person having an interest in any property who wishes to appeal the valuation, classification or content of the relevant notices to the Board of Revision is required to file the appeal in writing, together with the appropriate **fee no later than February 4, 2019**.
